## MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Friday November 11th is Veterans Day. As Veterans are on my mind, I felt it was a good time to provide an update on our Veteran's Monument project. Hopefully, you have noticed that things are finally taking shape at the monument site. The granite bases have arrived and have been set into the concrete. At the time of drafting this article, the smaller flag poles for the armed service flags have been set and the larger flagpole for the Stars and Stripes is being readied for placement. I'm hopeful that by press time this has also been accomplished. The large granite monuments are being engraved at this time and should be set sometime in November. It is exciting to finally see this all come together as very long delays in the supply chain prolonged this project by over a year. It will be such a beautiful tribute to our military hometown heroes when it is completed. We will be planning a ribbon cutting ceremony about two weeks after the large granite monuments are set. We are hoping this will be late November or early December. While we are waiting for this to all happen the Military Tribute Field will once again be in place in front of the city offices beginning November 1 and is scheduled to be there until November 14th. I encourage you to drive by with your children or grandchildren and view this wonderful patriotic flag display and tell them what Veteran's Day is all about.

I would imagine that most of you have taken advantage of the vote-by-mail program and have let your voices be heard. If not, I would encourage you to do so. The Veterans that we are celebrating this month have fought to preserve your right to do this small, yet very important duty.

Just my yearly reminder, from November 15 through March 15, it is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, trailer, any other vehicle, or object of any kind, on any public street or right of way while snowplows are operating or while streets are snow or ice covered.
