MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Another successful Founders Day is in the books, and it was a wonderful day for our community. It was awesome to get together and see so many of you in person. Thanks to all of you for making it a great day. A special thanks to all the staff and volunteers that make an event like this come together.

I need to address two very important issues that have a direct effect on our community. First let's talk water. Pleasant View's secondary water is provided and controlled by Pineview. I hope that each of you will follow their guidelines and reduce your outdoor watering so that we can go as long as possible through this season before they shut us off. The city has reduced their watering times in our parks, and it is starting to show. I would venture a guess that all of the city parks as well as each of your yards will look truly awful by mid-August. It is very important to note that once Pineview has been shut off there is no secondary water available. You will NOT be able to use culinary water (house water) to water your grass. This will be enforced vigorously with fines. Please think this through – it is NOT okay to jeopardize our drinking water supply that literally keeps us alive just to maintain a green lawn.

The second issue is fireworks. The North View Fire District Fire Marshal has BANNED fireworks anywhere north of the Ogden-Brigham Canal. I would urge each of you in this hot and dry year to consider forgoing fireworks this year. I ask for your consideration, if you insist on having them, please take all necessary precautions. I ask for your help, not to infringe on anyone's fun, but in this very hot and dry year, we have limited water supplies to fight fires.

Hopefully, everyone is aware of our Veteran's Monument that we broke ground on June 14th. How appropriate that we were able to do this on Flag Day. It is going to be a wonderful addition to our City Hall Square. If you haven't already gone to the city website and registered your Veteran, please do so.

We need to get the names collected and verified as soon as possible. Also, if you would like to contribute to this great project, please contact the city at (801) 782-8529 to learn of ways you can help.

Lastly, and most upsetting to me, is some news that we had an incident at one of our movie-in-the-park nights. Apparently, someone asked a single person attending the movie what they were doing at the event as this event was only for families and that she was making them feel uncomfortable and they asked her to leave. This is not in any stretch of the imagination appropriate. Our community is not like this. If anyone ever sees this kind of nonsense going on, please step in and help. Don't be confrontational, just kindly remind them that we are all part of the best community in the world and that we have a welcoming place for everyone.

Just a reminder from our awesome police, if you suspect something, say something. Report any suspicious behavior to 911. I encourage you to look around at your city and notice what is happening on your street. If it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't. Report it!

Once again, thanks for caring, thanks for all you do, and thanks for being good neighbors. I am committed to doing whatever it takes to ensure that we remain the best place to not only grow up, but the best place to grow old. Be safe and CONSERVE!
