Code Red Emergency Notifications



CODE Red is a calling system where Pleasant View City and Weber County Dispatch use land line phone numbers to relay a recorded voice message to inform you in the event of an emergency. It also has capability to use voice or text messaging if you have a cell phone. The CODE RED system can only capture land line numbers and cannot access cell numbers unless they are registered. Storm Water Reminder

Landscaping season will soon be upon us. With all the new houses and yards going in, please remember, *NO* top-soil, bark, or other material is allowed to be staged or dumped on the roadway. These, and other materials, can run downstream and contaminate our storm water system. Please remember "Only Rain in the Drain".



We All Live Downstream...

Stormwater pollution is the runoff that occurs from rain, irrigation and snow melt and everything that is picked up along the way as it travels downhill to the nearest stream, river, lake and beach. This runoff does not get treated, but goes straight to the waterways that we use for fishing, bathing, and even drinking. What is picked up by stormwater runoff is "people pollution" - fertilizers and pesticides, motor oil, sand and dirt, pet waste, trash and so on. All of this can amount to one dirty waterway; the Environmental Protection Agency actually considers stormwater the greatest threat to our water quality.

Since stormwater is "people pollution," we all play role in contributing to the problem as well as fixing it!
