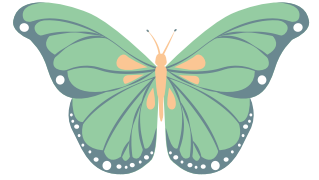

## CONSERVATION UPDATE

Please help us to conserve our precious culinary water supply in whatever ways possible. Severe drought conditions are continuing and anticipated to extend into the summer months. Simple things like making sure to wash full loads in the dishwasher and washing machine as well as shortening showers can collectively make a big impact.

Pleasant View City Code Section 13.16.030 strictly prohibits use of culinary water for irrigation. It is unlawful for any person of any residential or agricultural property, whether owner or occupant, to use culinary water to irrigate any yard, garden, or lawn. 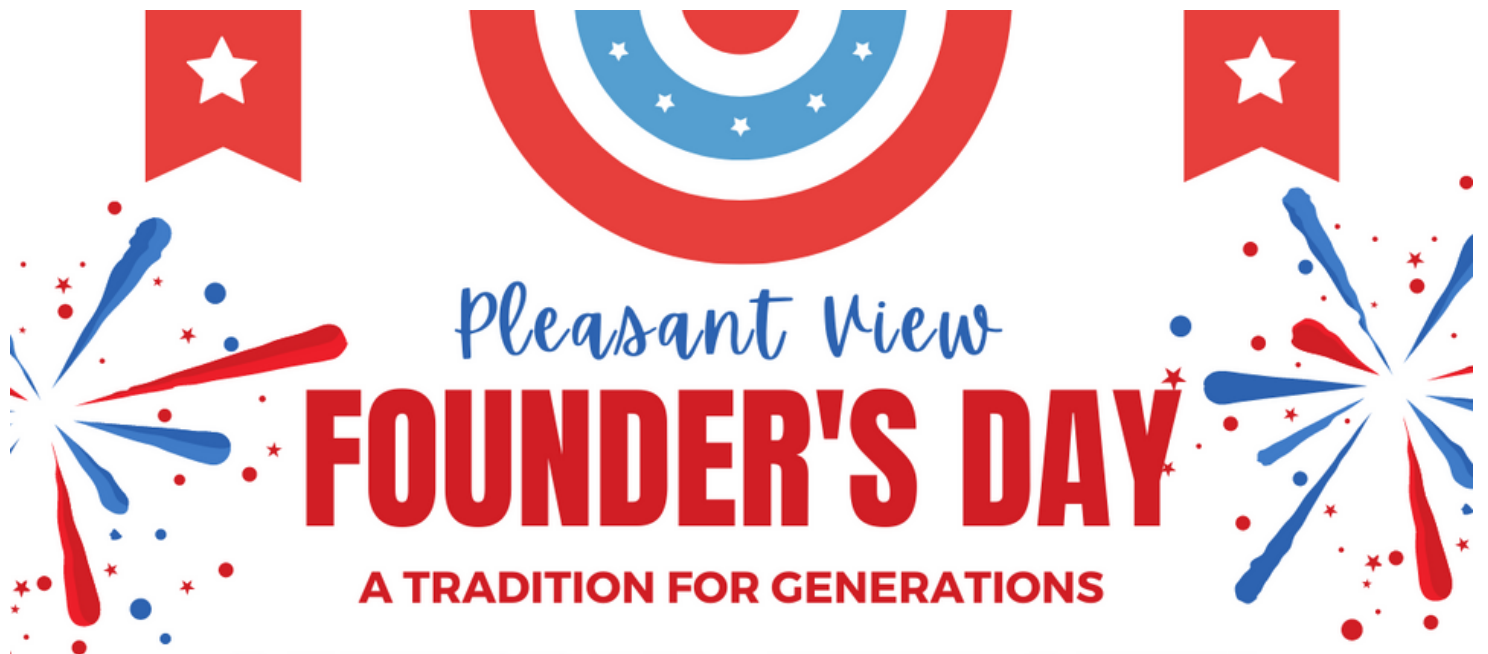
